Q: "This opportunity looks like a sole source to Harris. In fact, the county specifies Harris's gear in the Next Gen Final Solicitation pdf attachment on page 6." Therefore, my initial question to you is this evaluation correct?

A: No - The entire paragraph reads (bold added for emphasis):

St. Mary's County operates a MaCom EDACs, four-site, analog/digital simulcast, 800 MHz trunked radio communications system that consists of 11 full-featured dispatch console positions and approximately 1,600 mobile and portable subscribers. The County has determined that it is more cost-effective to **expand the system** to realize in-building coverage **through a system replacement rather than an upgrade of the existing technology.**

**All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.**

Except as provided herein, all items and conditions of the document referenced in item 9A or 10A, as heretofore change, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.
