## **February 4 Commissioner Meeting Rollup**

**LEONARDTOWN, MD** – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) began their business meeting with an invocation and the pledge, followed by approval of the consent agenda.

The CSMC then presented a proclamation in recognition of <u>Transit Equity Day</u>, <u>Dating Violence Awareness Month</u>, and <u>Black History Month</u>.

During County Administrator Time, the Commissioners took the following action:

- Reviewed future CSMC meeting agendas.
- <u>Approved</u> the State's Attorney's Office's request to convert their regular part-time Paralegal position to a full-time Paralegal position.
- <u>Approved</u> a letter to the Maryland Department of Natural Resources indicating that the Huntersville Rural Legacy Area (RLA) is the prioritized RLA for St. Mary's County.
- <u>Approved</u> a letter of assurance to the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission related to certain improvements at the Forest Run Wastewater Pump Station.

The Commissioners then received a <u>legislative update</u> from the Office of the County Attorney.

The Commissioners wrapped their business meeting with Commissioner Time.

The next CSMC business meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 11, 2025, at 9 a.m. in the CSMC Meeting Room, on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the Chesapeake Building, located at 41770 Baldridge Street in Leonardtown.
