LEONARDTOWN, MD – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) began their business meeting with an invocation and the pledge, followed by approval of the consent agenda.

The CSMC then presented proclamations in recognition of <u>National Developmental Disabilities</u> <u>Month</u>, the <u>Anniversary of the Senior Nutrition Program</u>, and <u>Women's History Month</u>.

During County Administrator Time, the Commissioners took the following action:

- <u>Reviewed</u> future CSMC meeting agendas.
- <u>Approved</u> the updated CIP sheet to reflect additional grant funding and the federal funding request letters for the Congressionally Directed Spending Request (Earmark) for the YMCA project.
- <u>Approved</u> the Department of Emergency Service's application for Federal Emergency Management (FEMA) FY2024 BRIC Funding Hazard Mitigation Plan.

The CSMC then received a <u>legislative update</u> from the Office of the County Attorney.

The Commissioners wrapped their business meeting with Commissioner Time.
