COMMISSION ON AGING - TITLE VII NUTRITION PROGRAM GRANT

Present: Agnes C. McGaharn, Senior Services Coordinator

Mrs. McGaharn presented the application for continuation of the Title VII Nutrition Project for the project period March 1, 1979 to February 28, 1980 representing a total project cost of \$86,444. The Commissioners were requested to commit \$9,289 in local funds as the local share of the project cost plus \$9,245 of local funds to be considered outside of the grant consideration, but as part of the general project costs for a total of \$18,534 of local funds.

Mrs. McGaharn explained in detail the grant application process and the grant document's contents. As is the County's policy the grant document has been reviewed by the Budget Officer.

After discussion, Commissioner Millison moved, seconded by Commissioner Arnold to authorize Commissioner President Aud to sign said grant application and commit the funds as requested by the Senior Services Coordinator. All Commissioners voted in favor.

In closing, Mrs. McGaharn extended an invitation to the Commissioners to visit the Nutrition Centers.
