- Request by Recreation and Parks for \$9,000 to offset costs of gymnastic center to keep fee from increasing.
- Funding for Chaptico Park and Carver Elementary School as a priority
- Increased health insurance costs and the need to find funds to take care of the shortfall
- (included discussion of possibility of requiring those employees on the traditional plan to convert to the HMO or PPN; discussion of the number of public school employees still in the traditional plan)
- To have the Director of Human Resources, Randy Schultz, come before the Board to provide analysis and recommendations regarding Correctional Officers compensation; a breakdown of the County's health insurance package and budgetary implications; analysis of Emergency Communication Operators' compensation; and a breakdown of the County's health insurance package and budget.
