REVIEW/APPROVE MINUTES

FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS

- Status 2001 Outstanding. No change in the status of 2001.
- <u>Status 2002 Outstanding.</u> No change in the status of 2002. The Ethics Commission received a letter from Mr. Forrest advising the BOCC believes it would not be in the best interest of the board or the citizens of St. Mary's County to take the actions against former board/commission members.

- State Ethics Commission Conference: Mr. Baroniak and Ms. Siemasko shared information and documents they received at the State Ethics Commission Conference. Copies of documents and the State Ordinance will be made and distributed at the next meeting.
- <u>Verizon Wireless</u>: A memorandum was received from Mr. John B. Norris, III, County Attorney, advising that Verizon Wireless has offered to State and County employees a discount for wireless cellular phone service. Mr. Norris questioned whether this benefit of reduced rates for wireless service may be passed along to County employees as a benefit without creating a conflict of interest. Discussion ensued regarding whether this came under Section 15.505 of the State Ordinance wherein it states you cannot offer anything to the State and County and not to the general public. After further discussion, it was decided to ask the following questions of the County Attorney: 1) Is it part of the contract or other contracts or very specifically limited to State and County employees?
 2) What is the definition of the "public at large"? Dr. Neal will email a note to Mr. Norris asking these questions.

NEW BUSINESS

Letter from Sheriff, St. Mary's County: A letter was received from Sheriff Zylak_regarding establishing a Citizen Advisory Board to the St. Mary's County Sheriff's Office. The letter requested the Ethics Commission's input and guidance on this Board. Shirley Baldwin was requested to draft a letter to Sheriff Zylak advising him that we would be happy to review the charter for this group. It was felt it would be hard to make recommendations without specific information about the tasks of the Advisory Board.
