III. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

- Membership Updates The AAC is seeking new candidates to fill committee vacancies.
- Election of Vice Chairman Defer election until September Meeting.
- Airport Minimum Standards Status and Update AAC closed acceptance of public comments to Minimum Standards. Inputs will be compiled and submitted to the County Attorney's Office.
- Economic Development (New Prospects for 2W6) The AAC Chairman had an informal meeting with Kurt Parsons, CEO and David Fluker, VP of Platform Systems, currently located in Lexington Park. This fast growing company is seeking to permanently locate their engineering and maintenance staff at St. Mary's County Airport. They are seeking to lease the county hangar for maintenance operations. The company wishes to establish a fully staffed FBO repair station to service the growing demand for General Aviation maintenance. In addition, the company is seeking to operate a repair/overhaul facility for the Beech King Air aircraft. It was recommended that Platform Systems prepare their business plan and submit an unsolicited proposal to the County for consideration.

IV. Public Comments

- Mr. Tony Pucciarella (representing the University of Maryland UAS Test Site as the Director of Operations) provided a brief on the status of UMD's site development, hangar acquisition, and operations plan for St. Mary's County Regional Airport. To address concerns about UAS flight operations from the based aircraft owners at 2W6, Mr. Pucciarella noted that initial flight operations for the UAS Test Site will be conducted at Crisfield with R&D being the initial focus at 2W6. Mr. Pucciarella added that any future operations from 2W6 will be coordinated with the local stakeholders at and near the airport. The grant application also requested the final funding to complete the design of Lawrence Hayden Road relocation. Washington Gas is developing their cost estimate and work agreement to be submitted to the FAA upon receipt.
 - County Development Review Report (TEC August 2014)
 - No major impacts or hazards to airport operations in this month's submission. The County will monitor three new minor subdivisions and ensure that appropriate notes concerning the airport are included in the record plats.
 - Airport Operations and Maintenance
 - Annual Airport Inspection discrepancies received and forwarded to start corrective actions.
