Mr. Ridgley representing Point Lookout Development Co., addressed the Board, and asked for consideration of the project to eliminate Mosquitoes at Point Lookout, previously presented to the Board.

Mrs. Adie Maddox and Miss Bartle, representing the Ladies Of Charity, advised the Board of the serious state of affairs of the family of Daniel Russell, Hurry, Md, i.e., Mrs. Russell has deserted her four small children, and Mr. Russell is not providing for same.

The same ladies also requested that steps be taken to commit William Mattingly, 12 year old son of Marshall Mattingly, to the St. Mary's Industrial School, he in their judgment not being in good surroundings.

Mr. Bailey of the Board agreed to look into the Russell matter, and see what can be done to help them, also in the case of William Mattingly, the Board promised to see what can be done.

Deeds of J. Wesley Freeman et al, and Chas. K. Clarke et. al. conveying Road Right of Ways to the County Commissioners, were received from Mr. Jos. M. Mattingly Clerk, and filed in this office.

Also the Deed of A. Edward Meredith & Wife, conveying to the County Commissioners a parcel of land in Mechanicsville, same to be used as a reservoir for the use of Mechanicsville Fire Dept. was accepted and filed in this office.

Mr. Clarence D. Bradburn requested the Board to take over and recommend the building of a road to Fresh Pond Neck, in the 1st. District. The road being in two sections and ~~#####~~ of about a mile each in length, and serving about twelve families. Mr. Bradburn was advisee by the Board to have Deeds and survey made.


