Mrs Henry Burroughs requested Board to commit 16 month old child of Adel Young, Chaptico to an orphanage, the mother being confined to a Hospital, and child in need of care. The Board phoned St. Elizabeths Home, in Baltimore, in an effort to have the child provided for. That Institution said the matter would have to be referred to the Board of Catholic Charities. The matter was turned over to Rev. Mark Shalvoy, Chaptico.

Senator Grayson requested the Board to recommend to the State Roads Commission the improvement of Grayson's Wharf Road. The Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Commission. See Letter on file.
