Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mrs Edna Sommers applied for purchase of Thomas Grant property sold at tax sale Dec.18th. 1933. Board agreed to sell this property for amount of outstanding taxes and cost to date , or \$40.54, cost of deed, recording and notary fee extra.

Mr. Paul Wakeman requested Board to recommend to the State Roads Commission the improvement of Queen Tree Road in 6th. Dist.

Mrs Edmonds requested Board to take over as a part of County Road System, the road which runs from near Adam T. Wibles Shop to Bluff Point Road, in 7th. Dist.

Mr. Ben Owens reported the Alms House to be in such bad condition that it was impossible for him to carry out his agreement for repairs at the stated cost of \$121.00. The Board agreed to allow Mr. Owens to order the necessary material, for which the Board agreed to pay, and also to allow Mr. Owens .30cts per hour for his labor and helper at .20 cts per hour.

Dr Campbell, Deputy State Health Officer, reported the condition at Flood Creek to be a health menace, and breeding place for mosquitos. Clerk was directed to write Dr. R. H. Riley, State Department of Health recommending that some action be taken by that Department to relieve the serious condition at Flood Creek. See letters on file.

Clerk directed to write Russell Cullins and Kitty Washington, owners of dogs depredating upon sheep and poultry of other parties , that these dogs be killed or same would be killed by officer of the law.

The Board decided to appropriate \$4000.00 for Old Age Relief for the year July 1st. 1936 to June 30th. 1937.

In the matter of General Public Assistance, the Board decided to administer that fund and that phase of the relief question from the Office of the County Commissioners.

In the matter of Aid to Dependent Children, the Board took no definite action at this time.
