Mr. Alek Loker requested Board to increase the amount allowed Miss Bessie Mattingly for damages to turkeys by dogs from \$21.00 to \$142.00 the amount recommended by the appraisers. The Board after careful consideration of the argument advanced by Mr. Loker, decided the amount of damages awarded Miss Mattingly to be fair and refused any futher increase.

The Board agreed to allow \$125.00 (yearly rate) for keep of Margaret Russell in some Institution for Epleptics, and directed the Clerk to so advise Dr. Frank A. Camalier, who requested Board action on the matter.

The Board authorized the payment of \$25.00 a month to the Clerk for extra work incident to the administration and disbursement of Old Age Relief and General Public Assistance Funds.
