Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mrs Burch of W.B. requested increase in the allowance given Elizabeth Barnes, Mechanicsville, Md. Board allowed \$2.00 month increase. Mrs Burch also requested funds to pay transportation of Collins children and Holt children to Johns Hopkins Hospital for eye examination. Board allowed \$10.00 to defray this expense.

Miss Anna Combs requested aid for Mrs Pearl Curry, Leonardtown, Md. Board authorized Mr. Wm. P. Wise to furnish shoes & Stockings for her children.

Judge Loker requested Board to install book shelves in Judge's Room. Board authorized the purchase of shelves . (steel)

Mrs. Matthews of W.B. reported three additional blind cases, and asked for funds to provide for same.

Mr. F. Tompkins Abell was authorized by the Board to Kill 2 dogs belonging to Lou Carter, Beachville, Md, and 1- dog belonging to Jno. Bean Beachvill Md, and 1-dog belonging to Corbett Bennett, California, Md.

Frank Butler Beachville, Md, requested aid from G.P.A. Mr. Clarence Bradburn was asked to investigate the need.

Delegation from St. Jeromes Neck, requested Board to take over as County Road, a section of road about 1 mile long, from the end of the present St. Jerome's Neck Road to the Bay. Mr. Frank White, Chapelear Bros, Mrs. Daniel Malone ~~#####~~ agreed to deed 60 ft right of way for the proposed road.

Clerk was directed to write Wmank Brown Charlotte Hall, to kill dog said dog having depredated upon the turkeys of Lloyd Anderson.

Board unanimously accepted the proposal of Mr. A.S.Jump, of the firm of E.Ernest Woolen & CO., C.P.A. for the audit of the Treasurers Office from 1931 to Dec. 31 1936, and directed the clerk to so notify Mr. Jump.
