Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mr. Jim Combs requested Board to recommend the improvement of 1/2 mile of Road between Great Mills & Indian Bridge.

Mr Roger Wathen requested improvement of Cedar Lane Road.

Mr. Frank Wathen requested the Board to take over as a County Road, a road starting at a point near Md. Springs School and running in an easterly direction to the May Pole Road, a distance of 1/2 mile.

Mr. D. W. Coppage complained of the Porto Bello- Great Mills Road, and requested relief, from this condition.

Mr. Coppage, also advised the Board that in 1927, the County Commissioners deeded 35 acres of land, known as part of Taylor's Lot, and belonging to Mr Coppage to R. T. Griggs.-Mr. Coppage requested that steps be taken in order that this property be returned to the rightful owner. This matter referred to Mr. King.

Mrs. Jno. Gray, Dynard and Mrs Julia Hoffman, Charlotte Hall, applied for G.P.A. Board granted Mrs Gray \$6.00 month, and Mrs Hoffman 4.00 Month.

The Board authorized the purchase of certificates of Release and Increase of Assessments, Tax Bills for 1937, and Monthly Cash Report Forms.

Dulaney & Vernay were low bidders on these supplies.

Board instructed the Treasurer to force collection of 1935 Taxes, both Real & Personal, as provided by law.
