

Board met March 23rd. 1937.

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Messrs Aleck Loker & Paul Bailey, futher interviewed the Board in reference to paying of Bounty on Hawks, Owls, & Crows.

The Board decided that a certificate of indebtndness be issued to anyone presenting the head or heads of hawks, owls, & Crows, killed in St. Mary's County, to any one of the three County Commissioners, or the Clerk, the heads to be destroyed by the Commissioner or Clerk, issueing the certificate.

The holder of the certificate upon presenting same to the Board of County Commissioners at some appointed time, will be given a check for the amount of the certificates held by him.

The Clerk was authorized to prepare and have printed proper certificates of indebtndness by the next meeting of the Board.

Messrs Wm. Fenwick, & Stephen M. Jones, requested the Board that funds derived from the Licënsing of Saloons in Leonardtown, be turned over to the Town Commissioners of Leonardtown.

Tha County Commissioners approved this request.

Mr. A. F. King, Atty to the Board, advised the County Commissioners that the Fisrt National Bank, had advised him that the said Bank would claim exemption from County taxes on personal property. The Board requested Mr. King to get a ruling from the Attorney General on this claim.

Judge Carpenter, and Mr. Briscoe Bunting, requeste the Board to recommend the improve ent of Bethel Church- Gardiners's Mill Road, a distance of $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles.

Mrs. Ernest Morgan, Laurel Grove, requested G.P.A, claiming her husband could not get work, and could not feed nine children, Board allowed her \$6.00 month, and authorized Harry Murphy, Laurel Grove, Md. to supply provisions in the amount of \$6.00 month, until futher notice.

Mrs. Godcharles, & Grover Stone, requested G.P.A. for Sam Tabbott, Chaptico, Md. Board allowed \$4.00 mo, to be sent to Etta Cooper, Chaptico.

Melinda Barnes, Ridge, Md. applied for G.P.A. Board refused to grant aid.

Mrs. Roland Higges, Craville, requested aid for her 14 year brother, Daniel Tippett. Board refused aid in this case.

Mr. Harvey Bailey called the Boards attention to the case of Jim Mason, Abell, Md, recently disabeled, and in need of help. Mr. W. H. Mattingly was authorized to provide food in the amount of \$3.00 per week until futher notice.
