Mr. Bradburn of the Board agreed to confer with Mr. Webb and Mrs McKay, in an effort to adjust the matter.

A Delegation representing the Mechanicsville Fire Department, interviewed the Board, asking what funds would be available for that Department, due to recent legislation. The Board advised the gentlemen in waiting, that due to the fact that the Bills pertaining to Fire departments of St. Mary's Co. had not been signed by the Governor, no information could be given at this time.
