Mr. Jim Combs advised the Board that Mrs. Joe McKay, Great Mills Md. protested to the alignment of the proposed Indian Bridge Road as laid out by Mr. Webb, of the S.R.C.. in that it cut off too much of her land.

Mr. Bradburn of the Board agreed to confer with Mr. Webb and Mrs McKat, in an effort to adjust the matter.

A Delegation representing the Mechanicsville Fire Department, interviewed the Board, asking what funds would be available for that Department, due to revent legislation. The Board advised the gentlemen in waiting, that due to the fact that the Bills pertaining to Fire epartments of St. Mary's Co. had not been signed by the Governor, no imformation could be given at this time.

The Clerk was directed to Write the State Roads Commission why work on the Beauvue-Valley Lee Road had been started as recommended by the Co. Comm.

The Board passed an order that each County Commissioner be paid \$100.00 for Administrationoof General Public Assistance for the year ending March 31st. 1937.
