Petition of Geo. A. Weschler et al for the improvement of a section of road leading from the Hermanville- Pearsons Road towards the Bay, was read and filed.


The Certificate of Incorporation of the Southern Maryland Tri County Co-Operative Association Inc., and a Petition of the said Association that a franchise and right be granted that Association to Construct # maintain and use a pole line, or lines, and to trim trees ### on, along, and upon any and all public roads and other public property in St. Mary's County, was filed with the Board.

Whereupon the Board unanimously passed the following resolution -

Whereas the Southern Maryland Tri County Co-Operative Association Inc has requested a franchise and right to construct a power line for transmission and distribution of electrical energy in the section of St. Mary's County now without adequate service and to use therefore the County Roads and other public property in St. Mary's County:

Now therefore it is resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County that a franchise and right be and the same is hereby granted to the Southern Maryland Tri County Co-Operative Association Inc. to construct, maintain and use a pole line or lines, together with all necessary poles, wires, stays, and other appurtenances thereto, and to trim trees necessary to keep said line free on, along, and upon any and all of ## the public roads and other public property in St. Mary's County.
