Clerk directed to write Mr. Webb, to view said road with Mr. Yates and advise the Board if State will accept this road as part of County System. See letter on file.

Mr. Chapelear & Dr. Chapelear requested Board to recommend to the S.R.C. the taking over for maintenance of two sections of road at Britton Beach. Clerk directed to write S.R.C. making the above recommendation. See letter on file.

Mr. Geo. C. Peverley Jr. applied to Board, to be appointed as assessor for the 5th. Dist., Board promised consideration of application.

Miss Lettie Marshall Dent interviewed Board, and advised that the Elementary School at Great Mills cost the County as follows-
