

Board met Aug. 10th. 1937.

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mrs. Philip H. Dorsey, representing Dorsey & Weiner, and Mr. DeSales Mudd, representing H. Norman Smith, requested the Board to refund certain taxes paid in error because of a double assessment. That is a certain property in 2nd. Dist ##### was assessed to C. B. Blick on which he has paid taxes regularly. This same property was erroneously assessed to Wm. F. Norris, and sold in 1930 for 1928 taxes, Dorsey & Weiner bid the property in at the tax sale, and later sold same to H. Norman Smith in 1932. Dorsey & Weiner paid taxes until sold to Smith. Smith Paid taxes up to the present. Board ordered Dorsey & Weiner be refunded the purchase price, plus taxes up to the time sale was made to Smith, and Smith be refunded County Taxes up to time Blick sold his interest to Weiner.

Mr. Wm. P. Wise advised the Board that he had been erroneously assessed in the amount of \$1,000.00, due to clerical error for the past 9 years, and asked for a refund of the taxes derived from this \$1,000.00 assessment. Board ordered that the County Taxes be refunded.

Jno. Alvey, Mechanicsville, applied for G.P.A, and Board allowed him \$8.00 per month.

Mr. R.H. Pembroke, Welfare Board, advised the Co. Com. that the term of office of Mrs. J. Julius Johnson, and Herbert L. Wise, on the Welfare Board expired Aug. 1st.

The Clerk was directed to write Mr. Milton Patterson, Board of State Aid & Charities, recommending the reappointment of the present incumbents.

Rev. Mr. Woodrow requested Board to supply funds to purchase an abdominal support for Mrs. Sarah J. Connelly, Leonardtown. Board did not grant the request, but recommended to the Welfare Board that Mrs. Connelly be reinvestigated for O. A. R.

Jos Huntington, Mechanicsville applied to the Board for funds to defray expense of child sent to Childrens Hospital By Dr. Sothoron.

Board directed Clerk to write Childrens Hospital Washington, that an allowance for expenses of \$2.00 per day for two weeks would be made by the County Commissioners.

Mr. Herbert Knight requested Board to take over as a County Road, road leading from Compton State Road, to Rosebank. Board agreed to accept deed for this Right of Way, and recommend same to State Roads Commission for ~~improvement.~~ *Maintenance*

Mr. H. J. C. MacDonald reported the Porto Bello Frog Marsh Road in the 2nd. District partially completed by the S. R. C. some time ago to be ~~###~~ in very bad condition, and that he would have abandon his plans to build on his property located on the St. Mary's River unless this road was improved.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Webb recommending the improvement of this road.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Lawrence O'Dea that Board would accept deed for Right of Way to road from #5 to Harry James Creek.
