

Board met Aug. 24th. 1938

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mrs A. J. Morris, Avenue, advised Board she was assessed with personal property, she has not owned for several years. Mr. Adams requested to investigated.

Mr. M. M. Coleman, Mechanicsville, advised the Board he was assessed with 525 acres of land, whereas a recent survey by Mr. Chas. Heard revealed he owns only 351 acres. Mr. Coleman asked for a refund on taxes paid because of this excess assessment.

Mr. A.F. King, Attorney to the Board gave the following opinion in the matter,

"The deed in the Land Record Liber shows 515 acres and until that record is changed, it is my opinion that this Board has no jurisdiction over the matter. Certainly no papers warranting a change have been presented before this Board up to this time!"

Clerk was directed to advise Mr. Coleman accordingly. See letter on file.

Leonard Alvey, Mechanicsville, requested funds to defray expenses of his two children in Childrens Hospital, Washington. Board refused on the grounds that facilities for such cases were provided by the State in Baltimore Hospitals, at no extra cost to the County.

Mr. Stantley Raley requested Board to improve St. Inigoes-Trappe Road. Mr. Webb was requested to attend to this.

Upon the second request of Mr. Woodrow, the Board allowed \$25.00 for the purchase of a truss for Mrs. Sarah Connelly. Health Dept. requested to take care of the matter.

Mr. Chapman Thompson requested Board to take over as County Road, a section of road from Clark's Landing Road to Blackstone. Board agreed to accept deed for this road after receiving a report from Mr. Webb.

Mr. Webb was requested to repair the driveway to County Jail, and also make a report on the road from Porto Bello State Road to Carthage Creek

Mr. Ike Weiner complained to the Board that his lot near Leonardtown was assessed out of line with neighboring property. Board ordered assessment reduced to \$200. per acre.

Board accepted deed from Hervy S. Knight, et al for Right Of Way to section of road from Compton State Road to Rosebank. Clerk directed to write State Road Comm. to accept same for maintenance. See letter.

Clerk directed to write S. R. C. asking that .3 mile of improved County Road at Potomac Viwe be taken over by State and maintained as part of the S.R.System.
