Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mr. K. O. Webb reported to the Board that in order to improve the Tall Timbers Road, it would be necessary to move the fence line of Mr. Geo. W. Russell back five feet, in order to get necessary width and alignment. Mr. Russell protested moving fence line, and stated he would give the required width, provided Mr. Juneman gave to Mr. Russell the same area in land that was used off of Mr. Russells land.

The Board decided to let the ~~in~~ interested parties settle the question.

Mr. Hammond Welch petitioned the Board to take over as a County Road, 1.1 miles known as a branch of the Cobrums Wharf Road.

Board agreed to accept Deed of Right of Way and recommend same to S.E.C. for maintenance.

Mr. Jas. F. Guy & Son, requested the Board to have the Tall Chestnut Road improved. Board directed the Clerk to write Mr. Webb asking that road be repaired.

Mr. Millard Tippet requested Board to take over as County Road, road leading from Three Notch Road towards Bay. Mr. Webb requested to make report on this road, and also to repair the Bushwood Wharf- Bushwood P.D. Road.

Mrs. Clinton Hebb requested G.P.A. for Ada Lawrence, Drayden, Md. Mrs Hebb reported Ada Lawrence as being the mother of five children, and expecting another one, without visible means of support, and deserted by her husband. Board granted her \$10. per month. States Attorney requested to apprehend the husband (Wm. Lawrence) and make him support this family.

Clerk directed to write Joe Hewlett, Scotland to kill his dog, same having depredated upon turkeys near Scotland. See letter on file.
