Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mr. Geo A. Weschler requested Board to take over as a part of the County Road System, a section of road leading from Pearson-Hermanville Road, into the property of Messrs Weschler Sam. D. Young et al.

Mr Webb requested to make a report on this road.

Miss Whittie Burch et al requested Board to take over as County Road, the Canoe Neck Road, 7th. Dist. Mr. Webb asked to make a report on road.

Mrs Raymond Goldsboro, Mechanicsville, Stony Dent, Helen, Mrs. Philip Bowles, Chaptico, Tom Langley & Ridge, Dallas Barnes-Park Hall, applied to Board for G.P.A. The Board granted Mrs. Bowles \$12. month, Held the Stony Dept Case over, and refused assistance in the cases of Goldsboro, Langley, & Barnes. In the case of Mrs. Philip Bowles, deserted by her husband, the States Attorney was requested to take action in this case.

Upon the application of Mr. Wm. H. Tippet, Park Hall Md, the Board agreed to commit Mrs Wm. H. Tippet to Spring Grove State Hospital. The Board and Mr. Tippet entered into an agreement, whereby Mr. Tippet agrees to pay \$50.00 a year towards the maintenance of his wife at Spring Grove State Hospital. Mr. King requested to prepare papers.

Capt. Joe Hazel & Mr. Dilehey, interviewed Board in reference to the Warheim's Railway Road,

Mr. C. Byron Guy, complained of condition of road from Compton to Bayside also road from Lawrence Valandingham to Pin-Cushion. Mr. Webb requested to look after these roads.
