

Board Met Nov. 23rd. 1937.

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Jessie Greenwell, Calaway, Mrs Chas Combs, Calaway, Sarah Gough, Leonardtow applied to Board for G. P. A. These cases were held over until next meeting.

Mrs. Mc. Williams in charge of the Recreation Projects in this County applied to the Board for the use of the Grand Jury Room for her work. Board granted the request.

Capt. Ed. Thomas, requested the Board to build a road into the Property owned by the Sisters of Holy Cross on St. Gee. Island, a distance of 350 yds.

The Board ordered that \$41.33 re refunded to Mr. M. M. Coleman, same being excess taxes collected for the years 1934, 1935, 1936, 1937, due to excess acreage assessed to Mr. Coleman.

Peter Fenwick, Ridge Md. and others requested Board to take over as County Road, Road leading from Ridge to Newtown, 1st. Dist. 1/2 mile. Road serves 13 families.

Mr. Walter Kirkman and Dr. Campbell, introduced Dr. Peck to the Board, and recommended that the County Commissioners appoint Dr. Peck full time Health Officer for St. Mary's County, in place of Dr Campbell now serving part time. The Board appointed Dr. Peck County Health Officer.

Board accepted Right of Way Deed from Minnie H. Welch et al for road leading from Ridge - Point LookOut Road to Harry James Neck, and recommended same to State Roads Commission for Maintenance.

Mr. J. E. Brown & others requested Board to take over as County Road, the Road connecting to Ewell and Warheim properties, a distance of 500 ft. Said road serving 7 families. 3rd Dist.

Dr. F. F. Greenwell discussed with the Board the conditions at the Alms House, and made several suggestion for the comfort of the patients there. Dr Greenwell also recommended that the Board allow no one to inspect the Alms House, without authority by law, or consent of the Board.

Dr Greenwell also suggested that the Board determine if the Board has the right to ~~#####~~ required patients to remain at the the Alms House, once a patient is committed there. If the Board has this authority, then Dr Greenwell suggested that patients be required to remain there and not go off at will.

Mrs. Matthews of Welfare Board reported 35 applications for W.P.A employment and requested Board to write Mr. F.W. Springer, 15NCourt St. Frederick, Md. the Boards attitude on W.P.A. in this county.

Board directed Clerk to write Mr. Jimmy Lyon & Zack Fowler that Board would accept right of way deed for section of road from the Milestown - Chaptico Road towards the Wicomico River at Mill Point Marm.
