Board granted Wm. Scriber, 4.00 Mo, The other applicants were refused.

Father McKenna, requested Board to have County Road leading to Cardinal Gibbons Inst. improved, and also to take over as a County Road, 250 yards of new road connecting Old County Road with No. 5 State Road. Mr. Webb was requested to make a report on this road.
