

Board met May 10th. 1938

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Andrew Gray, Mechanicsville, Thos. Fenwick, Bushwood, Janie Lawrence Callaway, Henrietta Chesley St. Inigoes, requested G.P.A.

Board granted Thos Fenwick, \$4.00 month, offered Morris Lawrence husband of Janie Lawrence work on roads at \$1.00 per day. Teh other two case were held over for futher information.

A petition was filed with the Board for the improvement of Willow Road from Jarboesville to Trailers Store, 8th Dist. Mr. Bradburn will investigate and report on same.

Miss Whittie Burch interviewed Board in reference to the Canoe Neck Road. Mr. Bailey will arrange with Mr. Webb to stake the proposed road out, in order to facilitate the obtaining of necessary Right of ~~Way~~ Deeds.

Aug. 24 1937, certificate No 45, 1938 Levy in the amount of \$28.75 was issued to Dr. D. St.C Campbell Health Officer for ~~compiling~~ Vital Statistics Data. Dr Campbell states he never received this certificate. A duplicate certificate was issued to cover the original with the understanding that the County would suffer no loss due to the possibility that both certificares are presented for payment.

Mr. Compton and Mr. Clarke, of the Standard Oil Co, interviewed the Board and requested a reduction in assessment of the Standard Oil Co. After lengthy discussion the Board left the matter with Mr. Adams for adjustment.

Board agreed to pay for a bandage for Stony Dent, now in the care of Mr. Leonard Alvey, but refused to pay any additional for his support, due to the failiure of Mrs Bush to provide \$2.00 per month for the support of Stony Dent.

Board accepted Right of Way Deed for section of road leading from main road to property of Sisters of Holy Cross on St. Geo. Island, and recommended same for improvement by the State Roads Commission.

Board agreed to accept Right of Way deed for section of Road from Three Nothch Road towards Chesepeake Bay, and advised Mr. Millard Tippet, Park Hall to have Deed and Survey prepared.

Board accepted Right of Way Deed for section of road from # 5 State Road towards St. Peter Claver's Church and Cardinal Gibbons Inst, and recommended same be accepted by S.R.C. for maintenance.
