

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Dr. L. B. Johnson and others requested the County Road from Longs Mill on No 5 to Three Notch Road at Oakville be oiled. Board promised this would be done when funds were available for same.

Mrs. Bonie Wood Morganza, Thos Hopewell Hermanville, Mrs Julia Hoffman Charlotte Hall, Thos Fenwick, Bushwood requested Board to increase the amounts they are receiving from G.P.A. Board granted Mrs Hoffman four dollar increase per mon, and Thos Fenwick additional two dollars per mon. Board discontinued the allowance to Mrs Violet Suit and Jas. Willis.

Mrs Wm. Gatton Hollywood, Mrs Alice Wood Mechanicsville, Arthur Thompson Compton, requested G.P.A.

Mr. Horace Bowling heading a delegation requested Board to recommend the Building of a State Road from Oraville towards Trent Hall, a distance of 1.4 miles. Mr Leonard Wood one of the delegation interested, objected to granting an 80 ft. right of way through his property. Mr Bowling suggested that the road be staked out tentatively, in order that Mr. Wood have a better understanding as to what might be required of him in the matter of right of way deed. This was agreed upon, and the matter will be presented to the Board again.

Dr. P.J. Bean et al petitioned the Board to improve the Road from Jarboesville to Traylor's Store. Mr. Webb was requested by the Board to repair both ends of this road for the present.

Miss Dent of the School Board accompanied by a delegation of ladies urged the Board to provide funds for additional room at Margaret Brent High School. Miss Dent recommended that the present auditorium be converted into class rooms, and an additional building 50 ft by 130 ft be built for an auditorium, with basement, said basement to be used for class rooms. Miss Dent estimated that this construction would cost approximately \$17,000.

Miss Dent also urged upon the Board the need of a Consolidated Elementary School at Leonardtown and Mechanicsville, and requested Board to ~~#####~~ ~~###~~ provide funds for these projects with the expectation of receiving federal funds to match the County funds.

After lengthy and earnest deliberation, the Board decided not to undertake any school building progarmme this year, and directed the Clerk to advise Miss Dent of its decision.

Clerk directed to Write State Roads Commission requesting that the Contract for the Building of the Beauvue Valley Lee Road be let.

Clerk directed to write State Roads Commission recommending that \$150. be spent on the St. Peter Clavers Road, and \$ 350.00 be spent on the St. George's Island Road. (Sisters of Holy Cross Camp).

Mrs Mc Kay Hollywood requested improvement of Sassfras Oak road. Mr. Webb requested to repair same. Mr. Phil Dorsey, Proj. Joy et al requested Board to improve Queen Tree Road, 6th. Dist.

Board voted to provide \$4,700.00 for Old Age Relief for the next fiscal year, July 1st. 1938 to July 1st. 1939, an increase of \$200. over year ending June 30 1938.

Board refused to grant \$355. of G.P.A. funds to Welfare Board for emergencies, as requested in Welfare Board's Budgett.

Board agreed to provide the sums for Aid Dependent Children, and Aid Dependent Blind as requested in the Welfare Board's Budgett, same being set by law.

Board Voted to provide for the payment of the Great Mills School Note \$1,100. and interest of \$352.00 , a total of \$1,452, due County Trust Co. Md out of G.P.A. Funds.

Board voted to reimburse C.G.F. for all withdrawls for payment of Hawk- Owl and Crow Bounty up to July 1st. 1938 from G.P.A. funds.

Board voted to provide \$900.00 for L.V.F.D. and \$400.00 for Mechanicsville Fire Department in 1938 Levy.
