

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Thos R. Langley, Ridge and Jas. Willis, Charlotte Hall requested G.P.A. Mr. Guy Herbert heading a delegation from 5th Dist. requested Board to sponsor futher W.P.A. Road Projects for the 4th Dist.

Father Johnson requested Board to have .3 mile of road at St. John's Church oiled. Board did not grant this request, as other oiling projects had been refused, prior to this request. However Board arranged with Mr. Webb to use salt on this road, #### to relieve the dust condition.

Mr. Lloyd Curtis requested Board to improve 3/4 mile of road leading from All Faith's Church towards the Plains. Mr. Webb requested to make report on this road.

Board agreed to place Robert Goldring in Alms House, the Welfare Board being unable to find a home for him.

Clerk directed to advise Mrs. Chas. Millison the County would pay \$62.50 towards the maintenance of Jno. Sacks at Springfield State Hospital, provided Mrs. Millison pays \$62.50 per year.

Mr. Webb requested to gravel a section of road from Paul Ellis' store to Whites Neck, complained of by Mr. Jno. Imirie.

Board accepted Right of Way Deed from Parran Tennison et al for section of road from #5 to Long Neck, 1st. dist, and recommended same to S. R. C. for maintenance. Length of road 6175 ft.

Board recommended to Mr. Webb as W.P.A. Road Projects, the continuation of the Baptis Church Road 1/2 mile, and the completion of the Oxaville - Morganza Road 1 mile.

Board unanimously voted to allow W. Board, \$300. additional for O.A.R, said amount to allotted from G.P. A. Funds.

Board concurred with the S.R.C. in awarding the Contract for the Beauvue-Valley Lee Road to R.L. Colbert, Fredericksburg Va. amount of contract being \$17,998.50. lowest bid.
