Minutes last meeting read and adopted.
Violet Suit, Mechanicsville, and John H Welch, Budds Creek applied for G.P.A. First case rejected and the second held over for futher information.

Miss Dent of the School Board requested the County Commissioners to make available \$9000.00 for the construction of an auditorium-gymnasium and alterations to existing school building at Margaret Brent High School the said \$9000.00 being the entire amount of the obligation of the County Commissioners required, to match the P.W.A. grant from the Federal Government to complete this project, P W A 1149 F.
Miss Dent explained that in addition to the \$9000.00 provided by the County Commissioners, \$4709.00 would be needed according to Federal Emergency Administrators of Public Works Estimate. This additional \$4709.00, Miss Dent agreed to provided from funds of the School Board and other sources, and is not to be an obligation of the County Commissioners.

Thereupon the following attached resolutions ##2 & ##3 adopted as a part of of the regular proceedings of this meeting.

The County Commissioners directed the clerk to borrow \$9000.00 from the County Trust Co of Maryland , at the agreed rate of 4% interest per annum. The loan to extend over a period of 10 years, and to be curtailed \$900.00 each year, until paid. The County Commissioners executed its note for \$9000.00, payable to the County Trust Co of Md, and deposited the proceeds to the Account of the Board Of Education, Construction Account-P W A 1149 F.

The clerk was directed to write Mr. Fram Self, Tall Timbers, the Board would accept right of way deed for .33 mile road leading into St. Georges Park, and recommend same to S.R.C. for maintenance.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Webb recommending the improvement of the road from Head of Bay to Loveville, and that 1 mile to Pincushion Road be built this fall.

The Clerk was directed to write Mr. Webb recommending that the Mechanicsville- Chaptico (Hilly- Lee Road) be included as a W.P.A. Road Project and to take priority over the two roads recommended at the last meeting as WPA Road projects.
