Mrs. J. Frank Coad, Charlotte Hall, Md. complained to the Board of a nuisance existing in front of her home due to parking of automobiles between the State Road and her front yard, and asked that the strip of land be closed to the public. See letter to Mrs. Coad on file.

A delegation headed by Mr. Roland Duke and others requested Board to have road leading into St. Aloysius Church Burying Ground repaired. Board requested the State Roads Commission to maintain this road.

Mrs. Mary G. Charles requested Board to take over as a County Road the road leading into her property, from the Budas Creek State Road. Mr. Webb requested to make a report.

Board accepted a Right of Way Deed from Roland McKay and others for a section of road leading from the Herring Creek Road into Mckays Beach. and recommended same to the State Roads Commission for maintenance.

Cecelia Green, and Mrs. Ollie Bailey applied for G.P.A. Board granted \$4.00 per month in the first case and \$8.00 per mo. in second case.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Jno. Briscoe Board would accept a deed for road leading from present County Road, through the Briscoe Farm to the farm of Freeman & Murray, 6th. Dist.

Clerk directed to get estimates on installing new plumbing fixtures in jail also installing new sheet rock ceiling for 1st floor of jail.
