

Board met Nov. 22 1938.

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Board accepted a right of way deed for a section of road, designated as continuation of Big Chestnut Road to Bayside- Compton Road, and recommended same to State Roads Commission for improvement, and also recommended to the State Roads Commission the improvement of the Big Chestnut Road which is already a part of the County Road System.

Mr. Gorman Swann and Mr. Jos Boothe Jr, requested Board to improve the Old County Road leading from Piney Point State Road to the Pettit property, 2nd Dist. Mr. Webb requested to make a report on this Road

Mrs. Celestine Clarke requested Board to accept a deed for old County Road leading from #5 State Road towards St. Peter Clavers, 1st. Dist. Mr. Webb requested to make report on this road, and clerk directed to write Mrs Clarke to prepare deed & survey, upon receipt of report from Mr. Webb.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Webb recommending the grading of the section of road from Chaptico State Road, to Gardiners Mill, 4th Dist.

In reply to a letter from Chief Engineer Nathan Smith, S.R.C. requesting Board to advise amount of money Board recommended spending on the Madenbour Road, (Mrs Edmonds) 7th Dist, Board directed Clerk to write Mr. Smith recommending that the road be graded, drained and surfaced with gravel at an approximate cost of \$1150.

Mrs Dorothy B. McWilliams of the Recreation Programe for St. Mary's Co, requested the Board to appropriate \$500.00 to purchase equipment for the several Playround Centers in this County. After discussing the matter the Board unanimously refused the request.

The Board accepted the bid of the Franklin Metal Weather Strip Co of Baltimore to weather strip the windows and door of the Court room, the amount of the bid being \$42.50.

Mrs. Mattie Wood, Morganza requested G.P.A. Also Jno. Young, Leonardtown requested Board to give G.P.A. to his daughter Elizabeth, a crippled child 22 years old. Board refused both requests.
