Mr. Ernest Adams requested Board to have an entrance box installed on the Porto Bello - Frog Marsh Road. Same referred to Mr. Webb for attention.

Dr. Peck of the Health Department requested Board to provide funds for transportation to Sabillasville, and to purchase a blanket and robe for Alice Thompson, Hollywood. Board suggested that Dr. Peck arrange with the State Police to provide Ambulance Service for this patient, and refused to provide the blanket and robe.
