Board met, meeting postponed

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mr. Combs et al requested Board to approve, as a State Road project, ✓ the building of a bridge over Indian Bridge Run, and about 300 yds. of approaches to bridge. Mr Webb asked to report on probable cost.

Mr. Norris, requested the improvement of road running from Great Mills Horse Head Road Towards Great Mills and leading to his place, about .75 miles. Mr Clovis, requested improvement of road running from Jarboesville to Trailors Store, about 2.7 miles. Mr. Chas. A. Heard Requested that the road from Wises Store to the Glebe School be drained and ditches opened. A letter from Mr. E. G. Dickey, New York, requested repairs to the Porto Bello- Frogs Marsh road. All the above projects taken under advisement.

Petition of John F. Gross, et al, for acceptance into the County road system of the Kingston Creek road, 8th Dist. and Father Dinges, et al, for acceptance into the County Road system, of road running from Lacey's Store to Camp Dinges, 7th Dist. Both taken under advisement.

Clerk instructed to request Mr Webb, roads engineer, to install a small culvert in the Patuxent Beach Road, near Bud Redmond's. 8th Dist and to make a resurvey, in company of Mr. Norman Yates, of the road running from the Leonardtown-Compton State Road to the Wathen farm.

Board accepted right of way deeds to, and made it a part of the County road System, the road running from the Valley Lee- St. George Island State Road to Piney Point Shores.

Board approved the appointment of Ralph E. Pegg, great Mills, Md. as District Fire Warden.

Board agreed to build another small Bridge, to cost about \$100.00 on road running to Foley Mattingly's, near Helen, Md.

Board appointed Benj. H. Duke custodian of the Court House and Grounds, effective as of December, 13, 1938, at \$200.00 per Annum, and decided the present Janitor service is satisfactory and no change would be made at this time.

The Board reconsidered it's former refusal to accept responsibility for the disposal of the remains of Rebecca Johnson, by the Maryland Tuberculosis Sanitorium, and authorized the paymrent of \$20.00 to this Institution.

The Board agreed to provide \$132.00 for Japenese Beetle control work by the Extension Service.

On the certificates of Dr. F. A. Camalier and Dr. F.F.Greenwell the Board committed May Teresa Graves to Spring Crove State Hospital, as of February, 17, 1939. And on the certificates of Dr. P. J. Bean and Dr. Joseph G. O'Brien the Board committed James A. Watts to Spring Grove State Hospital, as of ^{granted} March, 8, 1939.

Lina Sommerville, Compton, Md. \$5.00 per month GPA. and Mrs James Ridgell, Scotland, Md. granted \$12.00 per month for one month only. The applications of Mrs. Alfred Suite, Charlotte Hall and John Young, Leonardtown, for his Daughter, for GPA, denied. The Board allowed Fabian Barnes, Leonardtown, for three of the Children of Louis Barnes, deceased, \$12.00, and Nathaniel Mason, Leonardtown, for one child \$4.00 inorders for food until April 1st.

The GPA allowance to George Sewell, St. Inigoes, was ordered discontinued.
