Minutes of pree eding meeting read and aproved.

Commander and Mrs. Cecelia R. Loftin, Chaptico requested the Board to accept survey and deeds for right of way, andmake it apatt of the County road system, the road running from the Chaptico-Maddox State Road to thair farm known as Mill Point. About 1 mile. 4th Dist. The Board agreed to do this if Mr. Webb's report is favorable and the cost is not excessive.

Mr. Garner Hodges, Oakley, et al, requested Board to accept survey and deeds for right of way, and make it a part of the County road system, the road running from the Oakley State Road to his farm known as Barton Hall. About .75 mile. 7th Dist. Mr Webb asked to report, and to get in touch with Mr Hodges.

Mr. W. F. Pegg, Great Mills, et al, requested Board to take into the County road system .6 mile of the abandoned County road running from the Three Notch road to Hodgdon landing. Mr. Webb asked to reprt. 8th Dist.

Mrs. T.T.Hayden, Hermanville, et al, requested the Board to reconsider it's refusal to accept, as a County road, the road running from the Three Notch road, below Hermanville, to a development on Chesapeake Bay. Mr. Webb asked to report on this road again, and to get in touch with Mr. Paul Hayden, Hermanville. 8th Dist.

The Clerk was instructed to request Mr Webb to report on about 150yds of the Gardiner's Mill road that Mr. T. C. Carpenter is interested in and to get in touch with Mr J. Claude Johnson, Morganza. 4th Dist.

There was general discussion about the resurfacing of the Great Mills Horsehead road. No further action taken.

Mrs. Matthews discussed with the Board the need for an extra Clerical Worker and an extra Case Worker by the Welfare Board. No action taken.

The Board decided to transfer the old balance, \$446.40, in the Union Trust Co. of Maryland to the Com. Gen. Fund in the 1st Nat, Bank of St. Mary's, Leonardtown.

The Board refused to allow the charge of \$18.50 by the St. Mary's Hospital for treatment of Adele Montgomery, Hughesville, Md., on the ground that she is a resident of Charles Co. and therefor not a proper charge against St. Mary's County.

On the request of the County Health Officer the Board agreed to pay at the rate of \$10.00 per week, for about two weeks, for treatment of Walter Smallwood, in Syndenham Hospital. Dr. Peck reported that no other Maryland Hospital was equipped for the particular treatment needed.

On the reccomendation of Mr. J. Franklin Adams the Board agreed to pay Mrs Kate Farr \$50.00 for release from all claims because of a tax sale lot sold to her in error. The lot being the property of some one else. Mr. Geo.J.O'Hare, Attorney for the rightful owner, also to pay Mrs. Farr \$50.00.

Mrs Matthews requested GPA, for two weeks, for Theodore Campbell, St. Inigoes. And Dudley Herbert, Abell applied for GPA. Claims he has 7 children, one ill with pneumonia, and that he is unable to work due to rec ent illness. No action taken in either case.

GPA to Ella Reeder, Leonardtown extended for one month more.
