Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Rev. Franklin L. Metcalf, Mechanicsville, presented to the Board a written in reference to the Welfare Board's conduct of its affairs; also a written statement in reference to the conduct of the affairs of the W.P.A. Recreational Project, in this County. The Clerk was instructed to write J. Milton Patterson, Exec. Secretary, State Dept. of Charities: That while our official minutes ~~do not show~~ do not show that such approval was given the board feels that some approval was given by this Board to the St. Mary's County Welfare Board for the appointment of Mrs. Margaret Stevens, as an extra clerical worker, in the Welfare Boards office, and that it now desires to withdraw such approval as may have been given; and to inquire who, locally, should make recommendation for such appointments.

The Clerk was instructed to certify to the State Tax Commission the amount (\$129,529.00) of the assessment for the Maryland Light & Power Co. in this County.

Dr. F.F. Greenwell was appointed by the Board, Physician to the Jail and Alms House. Salary \$150.00 per year.

The Clerk was instructed to write the Governor of Maryland that the Board approves the three local laws (Transportation of children to non-State aid schools, Electoral Examiners and Extension of the Corporate limits of Leonardtown) passed by the last Legislature.

The Clerk was instructed to have published in the St. Mary's Enterprise and the St. Mary's Beacon the customary notices about the close of the 1939 levy and the Dog License law.

Mr. Hubert Z. Graves and Alfred Pilkerton, Mechanicsville asked the Board to improve the Kilpeck Landing road about .9 mile, 5th Dist. There being some doubt as to whether this road had been turned over to the State Roads Commission as a County Road, no action was taken.

Rev. Father Johnson and Mr. Jos. P. Wilkinson, Hollywood requested the Board to have surfaced about .3 mile of road running to St. Johns Church, to remedy the very excessive dust condition that now affects this church, in a very detrimental manner.

Dr. F.F. Greenwell, Leonardtown presented a petition for the improvement of the Macintosh road, 3rd & 6th Dist.

Senator Philip H. Dorsey, requested the improvement of the Cabbage Alley road running from the Abell State road to Mr. Joe Beitzell's, 7th Dist.

Rev. Father McKenna, et al, requested the improvement of about .75 miles of road running from #5 State Road towards Smiths Creek, near St. Peter Claver church, 1st Dist.

Mr. Stanley Raley, St. Inigoes requested the improvement of road from St. Inigoes to Carrolls Garage, Dameron, 1st Dist. No action taken on any of the above roads.

Mr. Ike Weiner, Mr. Tennison, Mr. Ridgell, et al requested the improvement of the Long Neck road, about 1 mile, 1st. Dist. Mr Webb asked to make sufficient temporary repairs to keep this road usable.

Henry Johnson, Park Hall requested G.P.A. for his brother Mathew Johnson who is paralyzed. Granted \$5.00 per month. Mr Vernon Dorsey requested G.P.A. for Geo. L. Jones, Mechanicsville, an epileptic, unable to work. Granted \$5.00 per month. The Clerk was instructed to restore Thos. R. Langley to the GPA. payroll at \$6.00 per month, and to advise Michael Shuman, Scotland to continue food allowance of \$4.00 per week, for two weeks longer. Application of Theodore Campbell, St. Inigoes For GPA. denied. The application for GPA. for Paul Davis, St. George Island denied because he is eligible for O.A.L. Mrs Julia S. Langley presented a petition signed by Dr. F.F. Greenwell, I.S. Johnson and Senator Dorsey Requesting GPA. for her. Cecie Green, Drayden permanently unable to work requested GPA. Edward Chisley, St. Inigoes,
