The Clerk was instructed to write the Governor of Maryland that the Board approves the three local laws (Transportation of children to non-State aids schools, Electral Examiners and Extension of the Corparate limits of Leonardtown) passed by the last Legislature.

The Clerk was instructed to have published in the St. Mary's Enterprise and the St. Mary's Beacon the customary notices about the close of the 1939

levy and the Dog License law.
