Miss Bushey, Dept Charities, and Mr. L.Herbert Wise, President of the St. Mary's County Welfare Board, and explained that all workers for the Welfare Board are employed by the Employment Commissioner of Maryland, and that when Mrs Stevens was appointed as a clerical worker, for the Welfare Board, she was the only one in this County who had qualified, for the position, before the Employment Commissioner. Rev. Francis Lee Metcalf having previously made complaint to this Board about this appointment. No action taken.

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Rev.Francis Lee Metcalf requested the Board to complain to the State Employment Commissioner about the employment of Mrs Stevens as a clerical worker by the St. Mary's County Welfare Board.

Miss Bushey, Dept. Charities, again appeared before the Board and explained the working of the Welfare Board and the process by which it was determined when a new worker was needed.

The Clerk was instructed to write Dr. Metcalf that this Board feels, after careful consideration, that he is the proper one to make his complaint to the Employment Commissioner, as this Board has no official connection either with the complaint or with The Employment Commissioner.

The Board refused to pay the Dog Fund claim of C.P.Speith for the loss of 9 goats, as the goats were not assessed for taxation.

On the certificates of Dr.L.B.Johnson and Dr.A.C.Welch the Board committed Jos. Grover Ching to Spring Grove State Hospital, as of May, 4, 1939.

Messrs Joshua F.Johnson, Glenburnie, and H.Melvin Bull, Balto. requested the Board to accept as a part of the County road system, the old road running from the 3 Notch road about 2 miles above Dameron to a proposed Development on Chesapeake Bay. About 1 mile. 1st Dist. Mr Webb asked to report on this road.

Board accepted Survey and deeds for Camp Denges road, 7th Dist.

The application of Hall Poe, St. George Island for GPA and Geo. Brown, Chaptico for an increase of his GPA grant, both taken under advisement. Application of Hattie Milburn, St. Inigoes, and Julia S. Langley, Hollywood, denied. The grant to Rhodie Barnes, Leonardtown discontinued. Miss Cola Burroughs Chaptico, Md. granted \$10.00 per month GPA. Theo. Campbell, St. Inigoes, granted \$6.00 only, divided into two payments. Grant to WM. Adkins, expired extended to next meeting. Grants to Jack Harper and Ella Reeder extended only one month only. J.W.Dent & Sons authorized to allow \$6.00 of Green, Drayden food, not to exceed \$8.00, one month only. Michael Shuman, authorized to extend grant of Victor Harry one week only.
