Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Miss Lettie M. Dent, Supt. of Public Schools asked the Board to make provision in the levy for starting a construction fund to build a consolidated elementary Center in the upper part of the County; and for funds to add to the present Colored High Schools buildings at Jarboesville. No action taken.

Board authorized DR. Peck to have erected "No Dumping" & "No Nuisance" signs at the Public landing at Foxwell's Point.

Board decided that the new trial Magistrate to be appointed for this County would use the Court room for the present.

Mr. Sameuel C. Long and Walter Higgs requested the Board to Accept as a County road - the road leading from Mrs. Godcharles gate to Middle Farm - about .75 miles, 4th Dist.. Mr. Webb asked to report.

Mr Raub Drury asked surface treatement of Airdale road about 1.75 miles 1st Dist.. No action taken.

R. B. Duke, et al, asked for the improvement of road to St. Aloysius grave yard, Mr. Webb asked to report.

Mrs. Casey asked that short piece of road running from State Road to Holy Family Church be made usable. Mr. Webb asked to do the necessary work.

Clerk instructed to write Col. Walter L. Simpson that the County would not oil surface any roads this year.

Mr. Webb asked to treat for prevention of dust short section of road at St. Johns Church - 6th Dist.

Clerk instructed to write Mr. Elmer Norris, River Springs that the County would accept survey and right of way deeds for the Palmers Store to Waterloo road - 7th Dist. *Without cost to the County*

Mr. Gresco requested resurface treatement of cut off road from St. Mary's City to St. ~~Jeromes~~ Church road. Mr. Webb asked to report.

Clerk instructed to ask Mr. Webb to report on the advisability and probable cost of improving the following roads:

The Mill Hill road about 1.5 miles - 8th Dist. Road from Leonardtown-Hollywood to St. Aloysius Grave Yard, about 1 mile - 3rd Dist. The St. Peter Claver road 1st Dist.. About two miles of the Macintosh road starting at its juncture with the Leonardtown-Hollywood road to Friendship School road 3rd Dist.

The Petition of Maj. E. H. Brown, et al for the acceptance into the County system of the road running Court Place to Oakwood Lodge, 2nd Dist., Taken under advisement.

Clerk instructed to write the State Roads Commission that they approved the improvement of the following roads:

To resurface with Clay gravel about 1.2 miles of road running from Hobb's Corner toward Blake Creek - Cost about \$350.00. Road from Leonardtown Compton State road to the Norman Yates Farm about .75 miles, 3rd Dist. *980.00*

About 1 mile of the Locks Crossing road 5th Dist. - Cost \$1400.00  
\$1250.00 Clarke's Landing road about 1.4 miles, 6th Dist. Cost About
