Being a special meeting the minutes were not read.

The purpose of the meeting being to confer with the State Roads Commission as to the expenditure of the County road funds for the State's fiscal year ending Sept, 30, 1940. It was the unanimous opinion of the Board that some means should be found to take care of the Debt service of the County road bonds without impairing the maintenance of the County roads.

The State Roads Commission, with it's Staff, arrived at 2.30 P.M., and Chairman Whitman explained the purpose of the conference and the estimated ~~xxx~~ amounts that would be available in the various funds for County roads during the current fiscal year.

After through discussion it was agreed (The State Roads Commission Concurring) that \$16,730.38 unexpended balance in the 1938 construction fund would be applied to County road construction during the current fiscal year, and the debt service would be taken care of by the S.R.C. from the maintenance fund; The use of the above fund for County road work enabling this to be done without impairing County road maintenance.

The Board adjourned at 4.00 P.M.

Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

Dr. Eugene Peck and Mrs Burch, of the Welfare Board, appeared before the Board in reference to the case of Augustine Plowden, a 17 year old colored girl who was about to give birth to an illegitimate child. Dr. Peck said this girl's mentality was very low and he was afraid the babies would continue to come unless some action was taken to prevent it. The Doctor suggested the possibility of a caesarian operation of a type that would effect sterilization, or her confinement as a feeble minded patient. Mrs Burch reported that the supposed father was willing to marry her and the Board felt that this was the best solution of the problem.

Dr. Peck and Dr. A.C. Welch appeared before the Board in the interest of Francis Herbert, a diabetic patient, who must have insulin treatment regularly and permanently. Both Doctors stated that he would certainly die unless he received the insulin regularly. Mrs Matthews, of the Welfare Board was asked to appear and stated the Welfare Board's G.P.A. funds were already pledged to the full extent of their appropriation. Dr. Welch stated that the insulin for the treatment would cost \$2.25 per week. The Board directed the Clerk to issue a check to the Welfare Board for \$4.50, the Welfare Board to provide a like amount, which would enable them to take care of the case for four weeks, and the question would be again taken up at the next meeting.

The Clerk was instructed to pay to W.C. Mattingly \$20.00 for the burial of James Suit, 2nd Dist' who's mother had stated to the Board that she was unable to pay for same.

The Board signed contract with the Burroughs Adding Machine Co. for a new adding machine, price \$110.00 less 10% and a trade in allowance of \$15.00 for the old machine, net cost to the County to be \$84.00.

Mr Bernard McKay, Valley Lee, Md. asked the Board to have removed from the coming tax sale a house and lot which he claimed to have sold to a man who after making a few small payments had thrown it back on his hands, and that he (McKay) was already paying taxes on the property. Action was postponed until the next meeting to enable Mr McKay to get a letter from Mr. J. Franklin Adams former Super. of Assessments.

The Clerk was instructed to send to the State Tax Commission the ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ names of George L. Lawrence, Bushwood, Md., Harvey W. Hilton, Park Hall, Md., J. Aubrey Norris, Great Mills, Md., F. Roger Hayden, Hollywood, Md. and Ernest Bohannon, St. Inigoes, Md., from among whom one would be appointed Super. of Assessments for St. Mary's County, this office now being vacant because of the removal of J. Franklin Adams from said office on November, 1, 1939 by the State Tax Commission.
