The Commissioners of Leonardtown appeared before the Board and requested that the \$250.00 allowed Leonardtown from County road funds be increased to an amount to conform with its percentage of the total assessment of property in the County, on the same basis that road funds are now apportioned to incorporated Towns in the rest of the State. The Board agreed to consult its Attorney and take this matter under advisement.

Mrs Matthews, of the Welfare Board, requested the Board to supply the Welfare Board with a list of the inmates of the Alms House, with a view to investigating present conditions in this institution. Mrs Matthews also requested the Board to provide funds for transportation of Sidney Hall to Harlem Lodge Sanitorium. The Board agreed to provide, from GPA funds, \$5.00 for transportation, and instructed the Clerk to provide the Welfare Board with a list of inmates of the Alms House.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Commission and request it to confirm, in writing, the verbal agreements arrived at, at the special meeting held Nov, 8, 1939, which was a joint meeting of the County Commissioners and the State Roads Commission, held at this office, Leonardtown, Md.

Board decided to postpone the next regular meeting from Dec, 26 to Dec, 28, 1939.
