This being a Special meeting the minutes were not read.

Mr. F.W. Springer, Dist. Supervisor, W. P. A., conferred with the Board relative to County road projects for W. P. A. Hesuggested that anumber of roads be approved as W. PA. projects, in order that they might have a "resevoir" to draw upon, and thereby enable them to keep their men steddily at work. He stated that if the County decided later that it wished to construct any such roads with the regular road force there would be no difficulty about withdrawing them as W. P. A. projects. The Board agreed to recommend to the State Roads Commission a number of roads for these projects.

Mr. Springer also suggested the possibility of building Schools as W.P.A. projects and stated that the County's share of the cost of these projects would be about 25% of the cost on road projects, and on School projects the County's Share of cost would be considerably heavier, due to the larger

percentage of material required for building costs.

The Board instructed the Clerk to authorize Mr.Lee Swann to allow Francis Ford, Charlotte Hall, food to the extent of \$5.00, under G.P.A.
