The Board decided to allow delinquent dog owners until February, 10, 1940 to get their 1939 licenses before starting prosecutions. directed to write all special officers for dog licenses in the County and request them to contact any delinquent dog owners known to them, and to issue any such owner a 1939 license upon payment of proper charge, until Feb., 10, and after that date to report promptly all owners and their address who have failed to license their dogs.

Mr. Jos. T. Booth, Piney Point requested the Board to construct a road from Valley Lee-St. George Island Stae road to his place. 2nd Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report.

Board authorized Mr. Thompson to provide a new outlet to #5 State highway

for Mr.R.L.Smith, St. Inigoes.

Brother Carlin appeared before the Board in reference to the roads to the Villa, 1st Dist. He felt that by far the most people would be served at this time by the construction of the Beachville-Villa road. He also recommended the building of the road from the Villa to its intersection with the # 5 State highway at Miss Daisy Abells, as soon as funds were available.

Wm. A. Herbert, Loveville asked GPA, claiming to have lost all his household goods in a fire. No action taken. Board authorized Mr.J.A.Cecil to allow Calvert Norris food to the extent of \$5.00. And Mr Raley Wathen to allow Delley Somerville food to the extent of \$4.00, and Mrs Ferrell food to the extent of \$6.00. George Quade authorized to allow Joseph Angle food to the extent of \$6.00. James Herbert authorized to allow Mrs Raymond Goldsborough food to the extent of \$5.00. Mrs Waring of the Wel. Board reported that they would be able to obtain funds from the State to cover half of these special GPA grants, and on this basis the Board agreed that if the need was shown to exist it would providez \$100.00 for February and March for such special cases of need.
