Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mrs L.H. Bass, representing Carl Pitner, Washington, D.C., Map Makers, appeared before the Board with a view to selling special State and County maps. The Clerk was instructed to order a County map at \$7.50 providing the map would outline the various Election Districts.

Mr. Paul J. Bailey, Atty for the Board of Education, appeared before the Board and stated that he had received a letter from Leon A. Ramsome, Atty. for the Parent-Trustees Association, stating that he would be satisfied if the colored Teachers of this County were paid ten monthly payments instead of nine for the next school year, and that he would also advise the above mentioned Association to accept such a plan if it was adopted. The Board agreed, that if the Board of Education adopted this plan, they would provide the money (Aproximately \$2750.00) to make this tenth payment to the colored Teachers for the 1940-1941 school year.

J. Louis Brown, A. Mills Heard and Richley Brown, asked the Board to accept into the County road system, the Glebe road, running from the Leonardtown-St. Andrews Church State road to Forrest Farm, about 1.3 miles, 3rd Dist.

They presented a letter from the preceding Board, which agreed to accept this road when the interested parties had presented a survey and right-of-way deed. They also presented the survey and deed. Mr. Thompson asked to report.

The Board attended a hearing at Swann's Hotel, Piney Point, Md. held by the U.S. War Dept. regarding an application of the U.S. Navy Dept. for a permit to operate a torpedo testing station in the Potomac River. No action taken by this Board.
