The Board accepted Roght-of-way deed from Jno.H.T. Briscoe for a road through his farm to a development on the Patuxent River, about .6 mile 6th Dist., and agreed to make it a part of the County road system, for maintenance only.

John Edwards Jr. requested the Board to accept into the County road system the road from the end of the present county road to Point Lookout Creek, about .8 mile, lst Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Edwards or Mr. Robt. Hewlett.
