Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Miss Lettie M. Dent Super., of Schools inquired of the Board whether any action had been taken regarding the request of the Board of Education that the maintenance of the driveways into certain Public Schools be taken over by the County as a part of the County road maintenance. Miss Dent was advised that the matter was now under discussion with the State Roads Commission, and that she would be advised at a later date just what could be done.

Miss Dent also asked that a small building (about 10' X 12', one story) be built by the side of the wood shed in the Court House grounds, for the storing of school supplies, as there would no longer be space for storing these supplies in the Leonardtown Public School. The matter was discussed by the Board but no final action was taken.

Mr. Foxwell Burch, Super. N.Y.A. was asked to have some records of the Orphans Court rebound by N.Y.A. workers. Since there was some uncertainty about whether the N.Y.A. could get a competent worker long enough to complete the work the matter was left open.

On the Certificates of Doctors L.B. Johnson and Frank A. Camalier the Board committed Harriet Gray to the Crownsville school for the feebleminded, as of September, 4, 1940.

Mrs Mattie Wood, Earle Keifer, and J.F. Tascher asked the Board to build a bridge on, and make temporary repairs to the road running from # 5 Highway at Mrs J.F. Lees place to its junction with the cross road from Loveville, 3rd Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report.

Judge Luther Miles presented a petition signed by a number of taxpayers urging the construction of a bridge and for temporary repairs to the road from St. Nicholas to Ford Town, 8th Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Benedict Smith.

Mr. E.G. Dickey was assured by the Board that the Frogs Marsh road, 2nd Dist. was still on the list for improvement.

Peter Biscoe presented a petition, signed by a number of taxpayers, asking for maintenance of the road running from the 3 Notch road at the Colored High School to Piney Hill, 8th Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Peter Biscoe.

Mr. Geo. E. Raley presented a petition, signed by a number of taxpayers, asking the Board to accept into the County road system and build a road from the end of the State road below Compton through Newtown Manor, about 1 1/4 miles, 3rd Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Clem Delahay.

Being a special meeting the minutes were not read.
Mr. Geo. H. Loudon requested the Board to maintain about 250 yds of the old County road from Great Mills to Jarboesville, 8th Dist. ^{now open access to the farm} Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Loudon.
Mr. Wm. F. Pegg requested the Board to accept into the County road system for maintenance road from the 3 Notch road about 1 mile above Jarboesville to the County road leading to Millstone, about .7 mile, 8th Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Pegg.
Mr. Harry Robrecht asked the Board to widen and improve the lower end of the County road on St. George Island, about 1/4 mile, 9th Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Robrecht.
Board directed the Clerk to ask Mr. Thompson to make a report on the road from # 5 Highway about 1 mile below Mechanicsville towards Trent Hall.
Commissioner Combs asked the Board to accept into the County road system for maintenance road running from 3 Notch road about 300 yds above Jarboesville to Mr. Yardley's place, about 1.5 miles, 8th Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Combs.
Board decided to construct a building of rough lumber 10' x 12' , 8' Pitch on the Court House Grounds for storage of School supplies. The construction work to be done by N.Y.A. and material to be supplied by the County.

Board adjourned at 2.20 P.M.
