B.M.Springer, 2nd Dist, appeared before the Board and stated that he had given the right-of -way through his farm for the Piney Point State road and felt that the old County road bed through his farm should revert to his farm. The Attorney to the Board ruled that this could be accomplished by the Board declaring this section of road to be abandoned. The Board took no action.
