Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Joseph Weiner, Atty. for Ann Dyson, requested the Board to refund to Ann Dyson the purchase price, and taxes paid by her since the property was sold her by the County in 1938, of the tax sale property of Jno. L. Biscoe, 8th Dist. This property was sold in 1933 for taxes, but the description of property given in the advertisement of sale was of the property of John Biscoe, also of the 8th Dist. The Circuit Court having set aside the deed for this property <sup>from</sup> the County Commissioners to Ann Dyson the Board ordered that \$37.28 be paid to her as a refund, and that the property be placed on the assessment books in the name of Jno. L. Biscoe, Heirs and resold for unpaid taxes.

The Board also ordered that the property of John Biscoe, which is not now assessed, be placed on the assessment books.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Commission that, since no provision had been made in the levy, they were expecting the S.R.C. to provide the money <sup>from County Road funds</sup> for the debt service in order that the County might not default on its debt.

The Clerk was also instructed to write the State Roads Commission and also to Joseph Chaney, Dist. Engineer and request that Byard Gough be retained in the road service, it having been reported to this Board that Mr. Gough had failed to pass the physical examination, but was not unfit for the road work he has been doing.

Judge Harry M. Jones appeared before the Board in reference to the erection of poles by the Md. Light & Power Co. along the County road to Mr. Chas. Grayson, 1st Dist. Judge Jones stated that ~~Mr.~~ Mr. Grayson wanted the poles placed near the edge of his field but that the Light & Power Co. refused to do this unless the County Commissioners would sign an agreement that they would not be required to move the poles <sup>at the County expense</sup> at any future date because of the widening of the road. the Board decided that they would sign such an agreement, and authorize the placing of these poles 15 ft from the center of the present road, feeling that there was no likelihood of any need for more than a 30 ft right-of-way on this road.
