Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mrs. Stuart H. Edmonds complained to the Board that she was being annoyed around her home by a colored man and asked that he be committed to a State Hospital for the insane. She was advised to get a warrant for his arrest, as there was not sufficient evidence that he is insane. The Board decided that: For their terms starting May, 1, 1941 the salary of Harry P. Wise, J.P. and Wm. S. Raleigh, J.P. would be \$75.00 per year, and directed the Clerk to see that provision be made accordingly in the next levy.

The Board authorized Mr. A. S. Jump to audit the books of the County Commissioners office during July 1941.

The Board reappointed Mr G. Alex. Hebb Inspector of Weights and Measures for one year starting May, 15, 1941.

On the certificates of Dr. L. B. Johnson and Dr. R. V. Palmer the Board committed Alethea M. Blackstone to Spring Grove State Hospital, as of April, 29, 1941.

The Board authorized the payment to Geo. L. Quade of a \$10.00 store account as G.P.A. to Herman Simms, who is ill and has a large family who were without food.

The Board also authorized the payment of \$5.00 to the Welfare Board to enable it to grant G.P.A. of \$5.00 each to Willie Nash and Luke Gray.

Mrs. J. D. Hurry, Wm. B. Long, James A. Latham, Paul B. Long, John W. Hurry, et al, appeared before the Board, and also presented a petition, said to contain 118 signers and a letter from Bernard F. Herbert requesting that the that the Landing on St. Clements Bay, 7th Dist. known as "Wood Landing" or Wood Yard, <sup>be declared as a Public Landing</sup> it being claimed that this landing had been used as a Public Landing back as far as Civil War times, at least. The Board authorized its Attorney to intervene in a case now before the Circuit Court and ask that the Court declare the above Landing to be a Public

Mrs R.H.Sears, Mrs.Harold Knight, and Charles S.Meyers requested that the road running From The Leonardtown- Compton State Road to Buzzard Point about 1.7 miles ,3rd Dist. be widened, straightened and improved. They also reported a culvert on the existing road to be in very bad shape. Mr.Thompson asked to report and to contact Mrs.Sears.

Mr. J.Loyd Bean requested that the St.Inigoes-Beachville State road be oiled, and Mr Albert Morgan reprinted the State Road at Scotland Beach to be badly in need of repairs. Mr.Thompson asked to see what can be done about these two State roads.

Clerk was instructed to request the State Roads Commission to accept into the County road system the Pegroad, about 1 mile, 8th Dist. for maintenance. *also the 3 hatch part about 1/2 mile & oil for maint.*

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mr.Geo.L.Lawrence, Supervisor of Assessments asked the Board to allow him \$300.00 per year for traveling expenses. In accordance with section 167, Art. 81, Md.Code, the Board allowed the Supervisor of Assessments \$200.00 per year for expenses, to become effective as of Jan,1.1941.

Col.W.Garland Fay, representing the St.Mary's County Library Committee asked the Board to levy 1¢ on the County tax base for the the support of the Library as the the funds formerly supplied by W.P.A. for the support of the Library were no longer available, and they had no funds with which to continue the service. The Board decided that since the levy is already closed for this year there was nothing they could do about it at present.

Clerk was instructed to write Governor O'Conor and request his approval of the local law providing for the licenseing of coin operated machines in St.Mary's County.

Clerk also instructed to write the State Superintendent of Schools that this Board is unable to comply with his request that Miss Dent be notified that she would receive before the end of the present school year \$153.00 on 1940 taxes. That the Treasurer now has in hand \$45.59 collected on State Tax Com.certificates for Corporation Tangible Personal property, that had not already been included in our 1940 base, and that this amount plus any amount due the local Board of Education from any further collections of 1940 taxes that might be made in the time intervening would be paid ~~before~~ to Miss Dent before the end of the present school year.

J.C.Taylor, Abe Weiner and Jno.W.Cooper asked the Board to have the St. Inigoes-Beachville County road surfaced with oil. Mr.Thompson estimated that it would cost about \$900.00 to oil 1.25 miles of this road. The Board decided that it did not have the funds available to oil this road during the present Summer, but authorized the treatment of it with calcium carbide at an estimated cost of \$150.00.

Louise Chase asked G.P.A. to get a Fastening for her artificial leg. She was advised to see Mr.Henry Fowler and try to get Red Cross assistance
