Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mr. C. B. Greenwell, Clerk of the Court and Mrs. Grace B. Beach consulted the Board about refunding to Mrs. Beach money paid for a 1940 Beer License as she wished to take out a Liquor License. The Board instructed the Clerk to refund to Mrs. Beach \$17.81 for the unused time on the beer license when she had taken out a Liquor license, which was done.

Senator Philip H. Dorsey Jr., Mr. James Waring and J. Julius Johnson requested the Board to underwrite \$200.00 of St. Mary's County's allotment of \$450.00 towards defraying the cost of the Md. Tobacco Festival the Board agreed to do this with the proviso that every effort was to be made to raise the necessary amount by private subscription.

Mrs. Edna S. Cawood requested a refund of taxes paid in 1940 on a house assessed at \$3400.00 which was burned in 1939. The Board instructed the Clerk to pay Mrs. Cawood \$34.00, which was done.

On the certificates of Dr. Charles L. Schmidt and Dr. Leslie B. Holmann the Board committed Rosalie Johnson to Crownsville State Hospital; and on the certificates of Dr. Frank A. Camalier and Dr. Francis F. Greenwell the Board committed John Prescott Price to Crownsville State Hospital, as of this date ^{and on the certificates of Dr. P. J. Bean and Dr. Frank A. Camalier the Board committed Charles Floyd To Spring Grove State Hospital, as of Aug. 8, 1941}

Miss Lettie M. Dent appeared before the Board and discussed the possible application of the law providing for the transportation in Public School Buses of children attending schools not receiving State aid. The Board decided that it would be better to defer a decision in the matter for the present.

Frank W. Warkart, P. B. Crandall and T. E. Griffith requested the Board to surface with oil the White Point road, about 1.25 miles, 3rd Dist. The matter was taken under advisement for future ~~consideration~~ decision.

Wm. S. Donaldson, Zach Fowler, Miss Eleanor Cantor, Jno. F. Briscoe, Jos. B. Curtis Theo. B. Carpenter, Wm. Donaldson, Jr., Perre Bowen and Mrs. Aubrey Gardiner asked the Board to improve the road from Budds Creek to Gardiner's Mill, about 3.5 miles, 4th Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Wm. S. Donaldson.

The clerk was instructed to write the State roads commission and recommend that an extension to the Tolson State Road at Piney Point be built with regular construction funds and the road taken into the State system, about .4 mile, 2nd Dist. This road being needed because of development by the U.S. Navy at its Torpedo Testing Station, and being a continuation of an existing State road.


