Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Daugherty had placed obstructions across their right-of-way through his land to their places at Three Notch Point, 8th District. There being some question as to whether the Board had jurisdiction over this road, the Clerk was instructed to ask Mr Thompson to report on present status of the Road.

Mr. Geo F. Omalley presented a petition requesting the Board to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, road running from the State road below Palmers P.O. to the North side of Dukehart Creek, about 500 yds, 7th Dist. Mr Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Arthur Mattingly.

Peter Fenwick and Father McKenna asked the Board to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, road running from the Three Notch road at Ridge to Newtown, about .5 mile, 1st Dist. ; and also another short section of road in the same locality. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Robert Bennett about both pieces of road.
