The Board approved Mr. Kings actions as Director and instructed the Clerk to pay Mr Britton \$30.00 from the Com. Gen. Fund.

In response to a request from the State Tax Commission the Board decided to confer with the Commission, at their office in Baltimore, on Friday Nov, 28, 1941, to discuss the question of a general assessment next year.

The Board decided to authorize its Attorney to institute proceedings to preserve the testimoney of old witnesses who can testify to the fact that the Public Landing known as <u>Old Wharf or Wood Landing</u>, on the west side of St. Clements Bay, 7th District, has been used as a <u>Public Landing</u> as far back as they can remember.

The Custodian of the Court House and Grounds requested the Board to fix his salary at \$300.00 per year to date from July,1,1941. Action deferred

on this request until the next meeting of the Board.

Elmore Blackwell complained to the Board that in laying out the Booth road, 2nd Dist. astrip of his land had been taken without his permission, and requested compensation for same. The Board called in Mr. Thompson, road Engineer, and he reported that anumber of reputable residents of the locality, including Messrs B.G. Swann, P.J. Medley and Walter Biscoe claim the land in question did not belong to Blackwell but was a part of the old Geo.C. Guyther estate. No action taken by the Board.

Maj.Gen.T. Holcomb requested the acceptance into the County road system, for maintenance, the road running from # 5 State Highway to Rose Croft,

about 1.5 miles, 1st Dist. Mr Thompson aske to report.
